Introduction

Information contained within this profile relates to either district or ward level geographies with the exception of the Indices of Deprivation 2007 which is based on Super Output Areas. This report aims to give you a snapshot of the Great Yarmouth and Lowestoft area at a given point in time. The Gt. Yarmouth and Lowestoft area is a bespoke area and where information has not been available at that level I have used Gt. Yarmouth and Waveney (the district which Lowestoft falls in). The information contained in this report is updated throughout the year and you can find updates of the Suffolk information contained in this report at www.suffolkobservatory.info. Furthermore, this profile will be made available on the Choose Suffolk Extranet, www.choosesuffolk.com/extranet.

The main body of the profile provides an analysis of datasets grouped under the broad themes of the Observatory, whilst the appendix contains a more detailed ward level analysis.

1. Economic

1.1 Business Formations

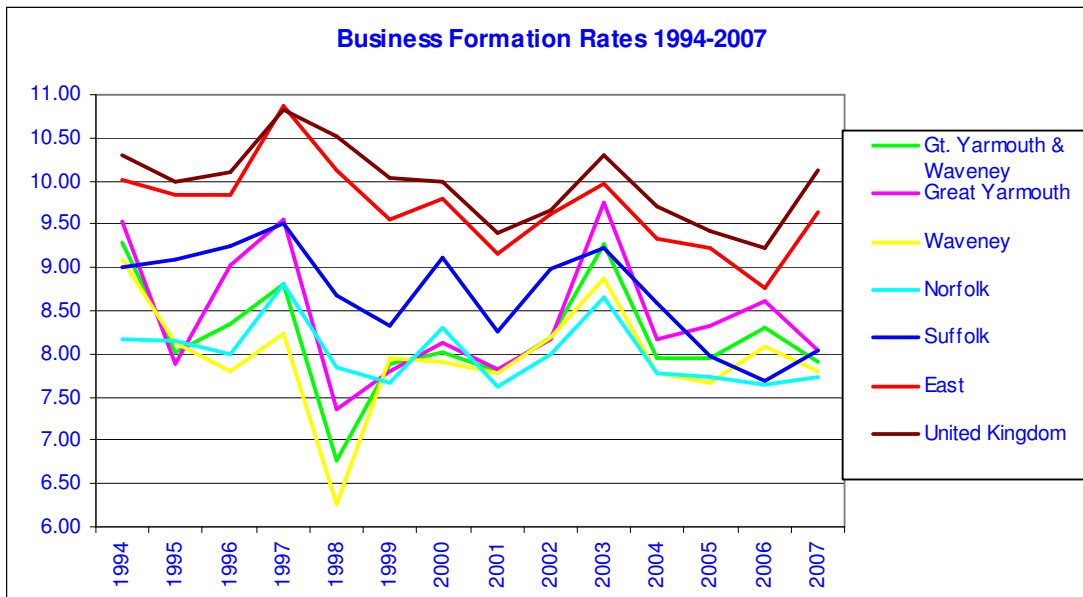
VAT registrations and deregistrations are used as proxy measures of business formations and closures respectively; however it is important to note that the current turnover threshold at which businesses have to register for VAT is £60,000. Therefore many micro-businesses are omitted from the analysis.

Table 1 (below) shows that since 2001, the business registrations have always exceeded the deregistrations. The business formation rate is the number of businesses registering for VAT as a percentage of the stock of VAT registered businesses.

Chart 1 above shows that business formation rates in Gt. Yarmouth & Waveney have been consistently lower than regional and national rates since 1994. It has also been constantly lower than the county of Suffolk other than in 1994, 2003 and 2006. It has however, been consistently higher than Norfolk since 1999 other than in 2000. Overall the Business Formation Rate in Suffolk and Norfolk has been significantly lower than the East of England and the UK since 1994. Whilst Suffolk, Norfolk, East of England and UK have had an increase the Business Formation Rate from 2006-2007 there has been a decrease in Waveney and Great Yarmouth.

1.2 House Prices

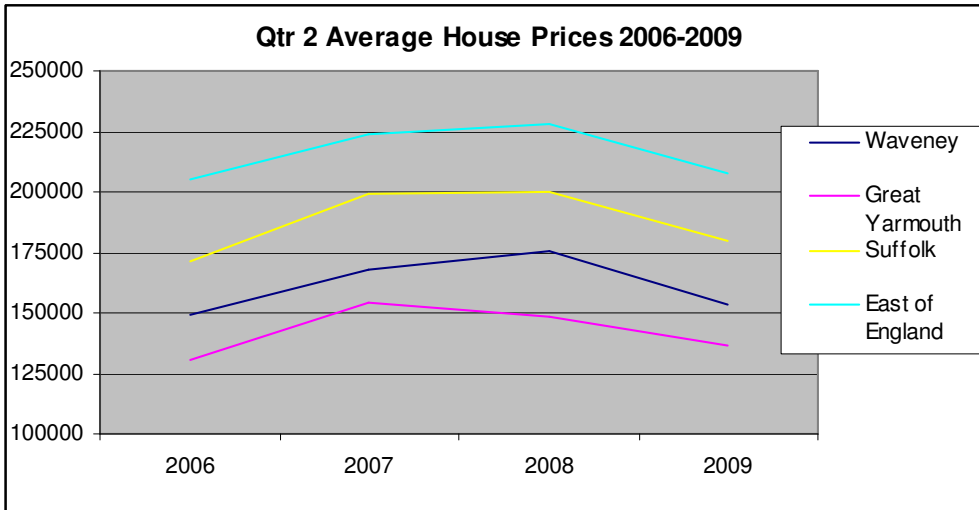
The cost of housing has a significant influence on the national and local economy. Nationally, the Bank of England will increase and decrease the cost of mortgages to either boost or dampen consumer demand. Locally, high housing costs affect labour supply and the ability of local first time buyers to get on the property ladder in their own area. Table 2 (below) provides a summary of house prices by housing type.

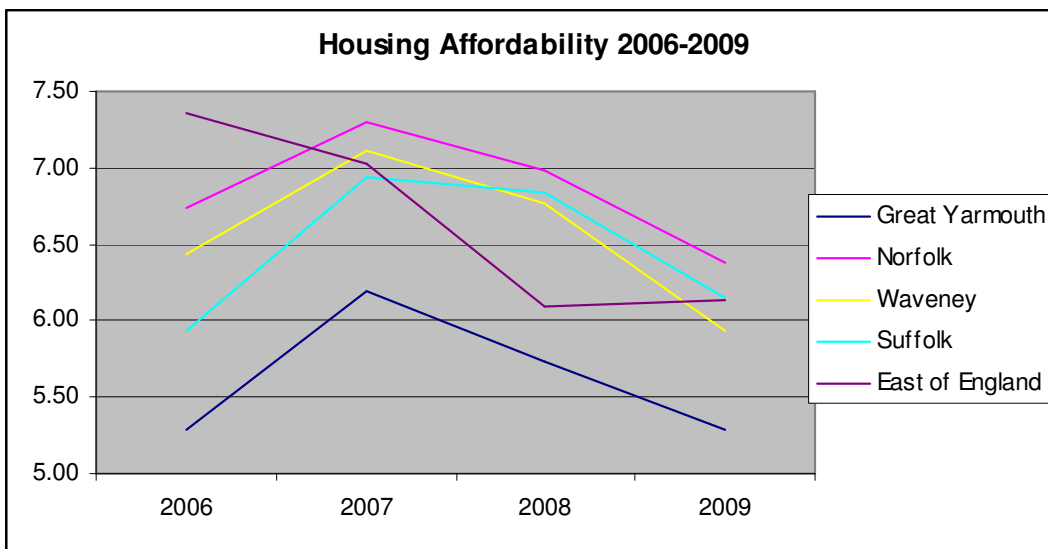
Since 2006 to 2009, house prices in Great Yarmouth and Waveney have increased slightly by 4.15% and 3.15% respectively. The county and region also follow this trend as chart 2 (below) shows. Average house prices in Babergh are still significantly higher than that of the county but remain slightly lower than that of the region since 2008.

1.3 Housing Affordability

Housing affordability has become a key issue in recent years due to the massive price increases experienced within the housing market. A widely used method of determining housing affordability is the price/earnings ratio, which assumes that house buyers have a 5% deposit and then calculates the ratio of annual salary against 95% of average house prices. Chart 3 (below) shows the trend in the price/ earnings ratio.

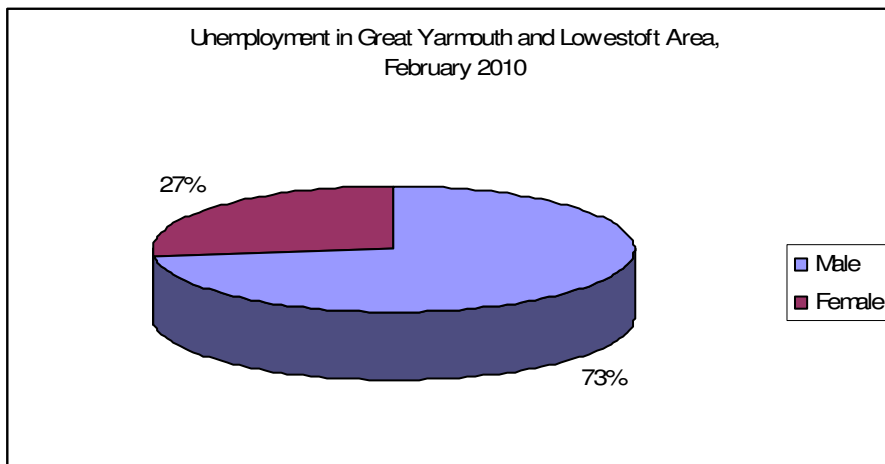
Due to house prices falling and earnings increasing slightly as well as the current economic climate, housing has generally become more affordable across the region. Great Yarmouth (-0.06%), Waveney (-7.83%), Norfolk (-5.23%) and the East of England (-16.49%) have all had a drop in housing affordability between 2006 and 2009 (quarter 2) meaning houses are becoming more affordable. Only Suffolk (3.76%) and Mid Suffolk (28.40%) experienced a rise in housing affordability within that time which resulted in houses being less affordable in quarter 2 of 2009 than in quarter 2 of 2006 in those two areas across both counties.

2. Labour Market

2.1 Unemployment

The way we measure unemployment is through the claimant count statistics. This shows us the number of people claiming unemployment benefits and therefore gives us a most up to date picture of how many people are unemployed. However, a district level analysis of unemployment only provides a general picture, and in order to get a better understanding of the pattern it is best to analyse ward level data. Ward level data is available in the appendices.

The pie chart below shows the breakdown within the Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft area of males and females claiming unemployment benefits in February 2010. Males make up 73% of the total claimants in September 2009 with females only making up 27% of total claimants.

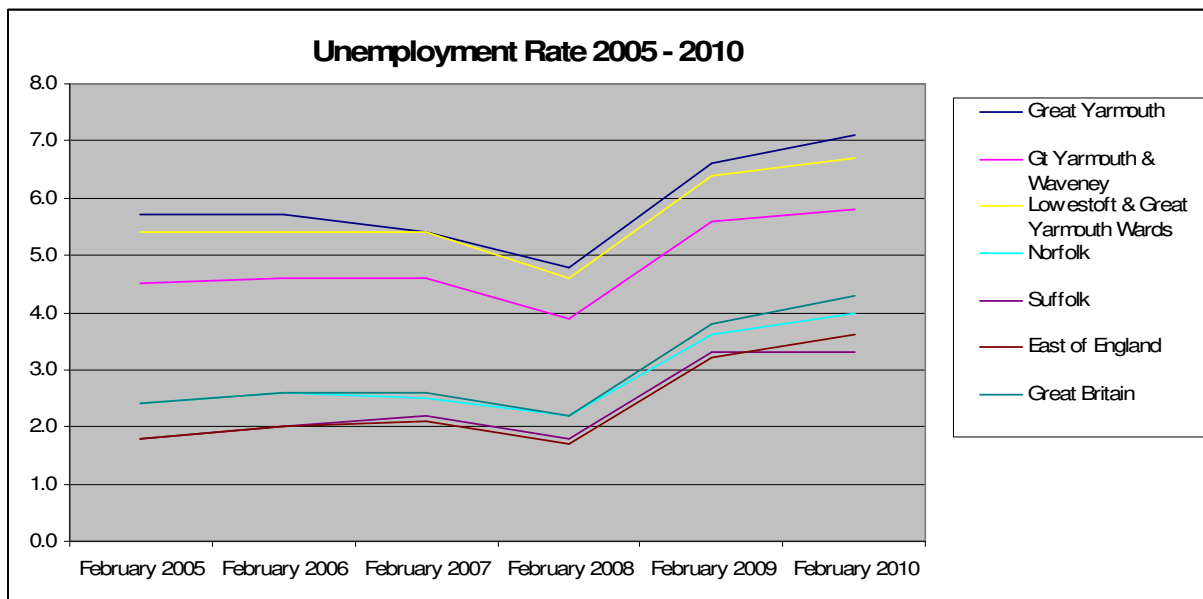

The table shows that unemployment in the Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft area is the highest in Suffolk and Norfolk and is significantly higher than the counties rate as well as the regional and national rate. As expected, the number of people unemployed has increased dramatically over the last two years.



The table below shows the percentage change for each of the areas over a short and medium term. Great Yarmouth and Lowestoft area experienced the lowest percentage rise in the number of people becoming unemployed over the last 5 years. The change in the number of people becoming unemployed over the last five years was significantly lower in Great Yarmouth and Waveney area that the county of Norfolk and Suffolk and the regional and national figures. Over the last year some areas have seen a reduction in the number of people becoming unemployed with St. Edmundsbury seeing the greatest reduction of 10%. Waveney and Suffolk also saw a reduction of 2% and 1% respectively.

Lowestoft & Great Yarmouth area follows the trend of all the other districts, counties and the region and nation with the majority of the claimants falling into the 20-39 years age bracket. The lowest percentage of claimants are in the 60+ age group, this has been constantly the case since 2004.

2.1.3 Female Unemployment

Of the 27% total claimants that females make up in Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft area, 47% are in the 20-39 year old category. This trend follows through the counties, region and nation, all having the highest number of unemployment claimants within the 20-39 age range. This has always been the case since 2004 other than in 2006 where the female 40-59 year olds had a slightly higher percentage of claimants.

2.1.4 Unemployment by Duration

The table below shows us that 66% of total benefit claimants in the Lowestoft & Gt. Yarmouth area are claiming the benefit for less than 6 months. This is slightly higher than the Norfolk and Great Britain rate and the same as the Suffolk and East of England rate. 26% of claimants in the Lowestoft and Great Yarmouth area take 6-12 months to stop claiming the benefit which is lower than Norfolk, East of England and Great Britain rate

2.2 Economic Activity

Economic activity is a measure of the available workforce in a particular area and it includes those people who are in employment or unemployed but excludes pensioners, the long-term sick and students. The economic activity rates expresses this number as a proportion of the working age population.

Table 4 (below) shows the current economic activity rate in Gt. Yarmouth and Waveney as well as the change in economic activity between 2007 and 2008. Gt. Yarmouth and Waveney's economic activity rate is currently lower than the counties, regional and national rate. The rate of economic activity in Gt. Yarmouth and Waveney has decreased between 2007 and 2008 by 1.5% which followed in line with Great Yarmouth district's rate falling by 6.3% and Norfolk's rate falling by 2.5% in the same period. Waveney and Suffolk's rate rose by 2.1% and 3.2% respectively. Which followed the trend for the East of England and the United Kingdom.

2.3 Employment

2.3.1 Employment Rates

The employment rate measures the proportion of the working age population who are in employment. Table 5 (below) shows the current employment rate in Gt.Yarmouth & Waveney compared to the relevant districts, counties and the region. Gt. Yarmouth & Waveney have a worse employment rate in 2008 than the counties, region and national rates. It has a lower rate than Waveney as a district alone but higher than Gt.Yarmouth as a district on its own. It did have a slight increase in the employment rate from 2007 by 0.4% which was better than Great Yarmouth, Norfolk, East of England and the UK who all had a decrease in employment levels between 2007 and 2008.

2.3.2 Employment Structure

According to the Annual Business Inquiry there were 76,364 people in employment in Gt. Yarmouth & Waveney in 2007. Since 2006 employment in the district has decreased by 1681 (-2.2%). The distribution, hotels & restaurants and the public administration, education sector accounted for the largest proportion of employees (28%), followed by manufacturing which accounted for 16%.

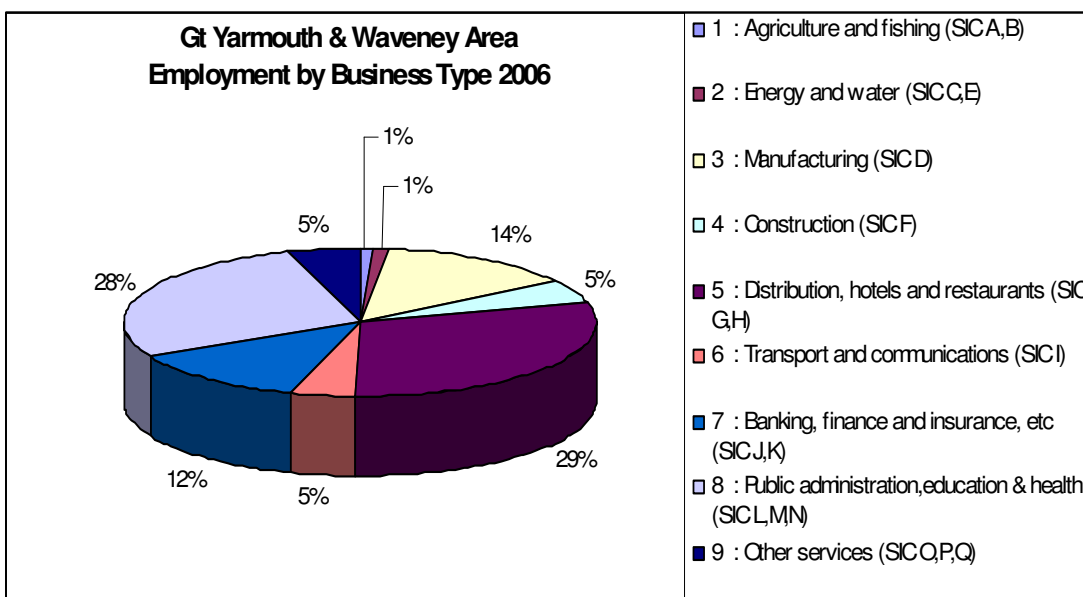
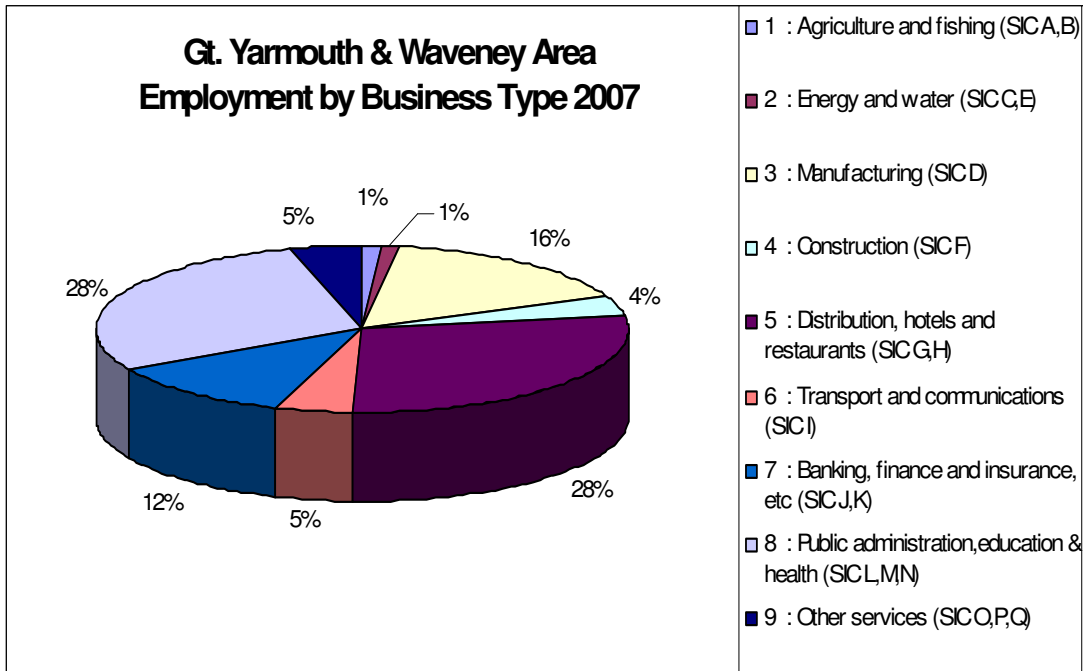

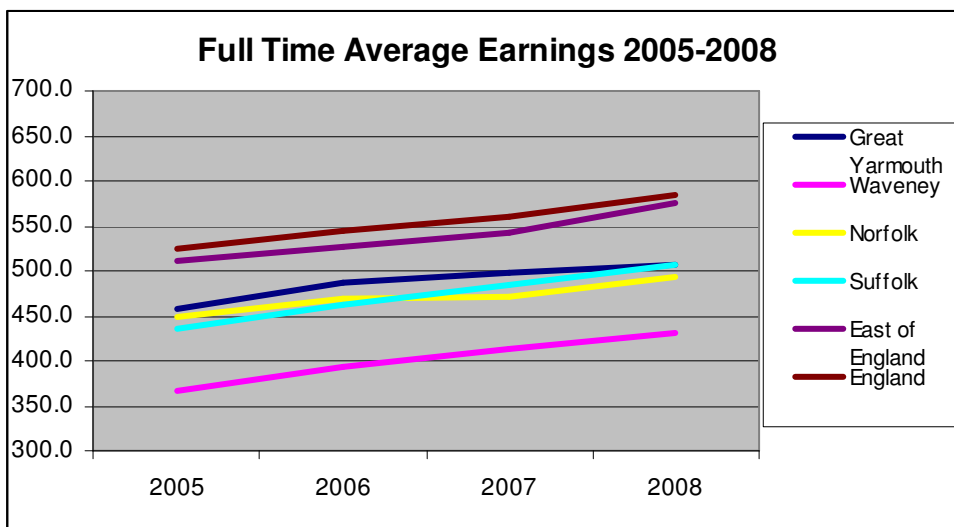
In comparison with the county and the region, Gt Yarmouth & Waveney has a higher concentration of employment in the manufacturing and distribution and the hotels and restaurant sectors.

Only Agriculture, energy and water and construction were the only sectors to see an increase in employment in Gt. Yarmouth & Waveney area between 2006 and 2007. Energy saw the biggest increase at 12% where as transport and communications saw the biggest decrease in employment at -6%.



2.4 Average Earnings

Average earnings could not be calculated as a bespoke area of Gt. Yarmouth and Waveney or Lowestoft so I have used the standard district figures. Gt Yarmouth's average full time wage is significantly higher than Waveney's in 2008 at £507 and £432 respectively. An estimated joint average of this would give a figure of £470 per week full time for the Gt. Yarmouth and Waveney area. The graph below shows the average full time earnings for 2005 until 2008.

The difference between male and female pay rates differs greatly between the districts in the counties of Norfolk and Suffolk, although all full time males received more than full time females. Gt. Yarmouth, however, had the 3rd highest difference with full time males receiving on average 32% more than full time females. Only Forest Heath and Suffolk Coastal had a higher difference (40% & 38% respectively.) Interestingly Waveney has the second lowest difference at 12% with only Mid Suffolk having a lesser difference of 0.1%.

2.5 Occupational Trends

Occupational trends show the types of jobs people in each of the areas hold.

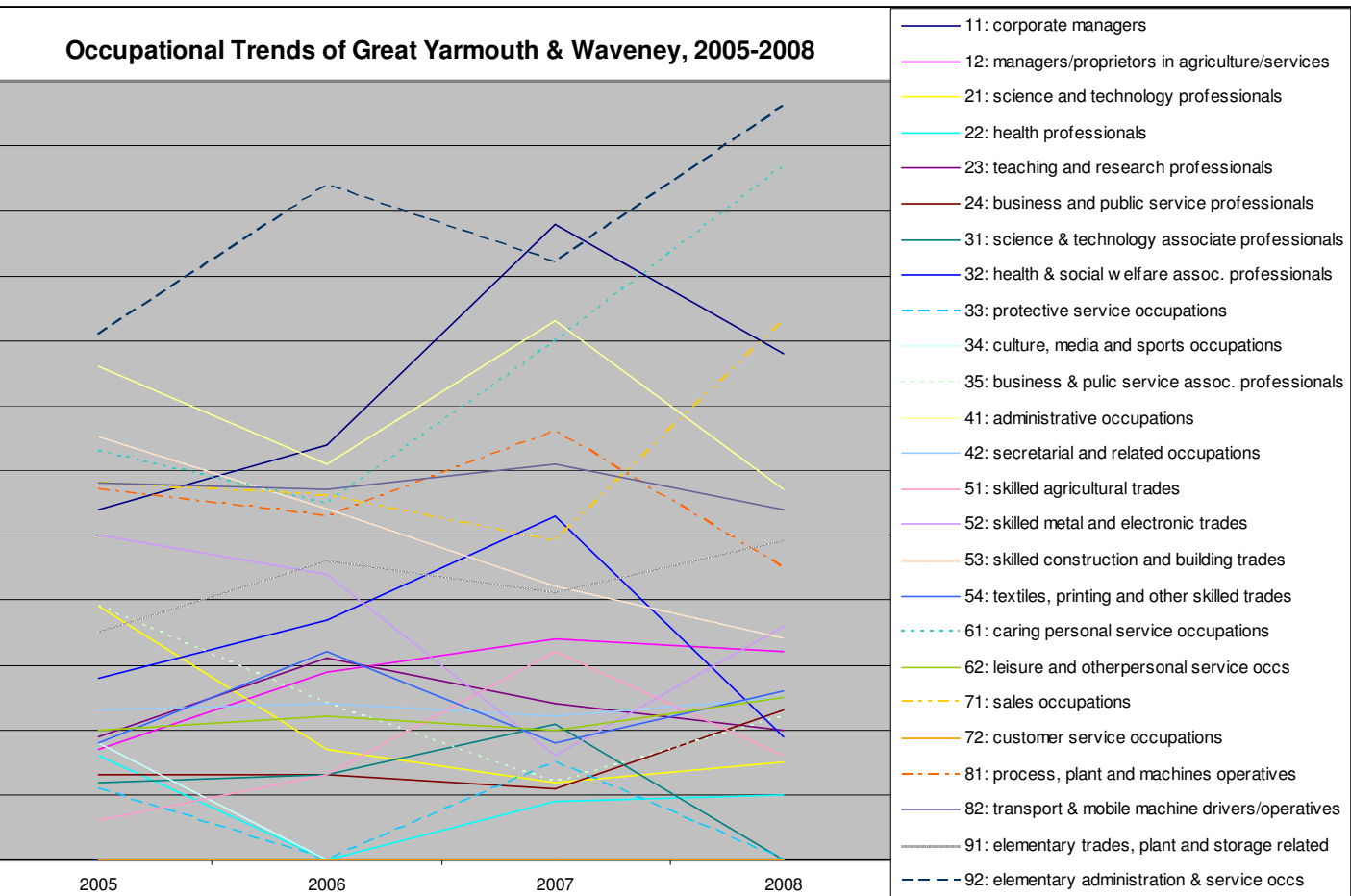

Great Yarmouth & Waveney have a high percentage of employees working in the elementary administration & service occupation at 12.7%. This is the highest percent of

employees within Great Yarmouth and Waveney but also higher than the counties, region and national rate for employees in this occupation. This is the only occupation that Great Yarmouth & Waveney have a higher percentage of employees working in than all the other geographies. Great Yarmouth & Waveney have the lowest amount of employees working as health professionals (1.1%) although this followed throughout the counties, region and nation as well. This was followed by Science and Technology professionals. Great Yarmouth & Waveney had on 1.6% of its working population in this occupation compared to 2.7% and 2.3% in Norfolk and Suffolk; and 4.2% and 3.8% in the East of England and England respectively.

As you can see from the graph above elementary administration & service occupations, caring personal service occupations, sales occupations, elementary trades, plant and storage related occupations, managers/proprietors in agricultural services occupations, skilled agricultural trade occupations, secretarial and related occupations, leisure and other personal service occupations, textiles, printing and other skilled trades, business and public service professional occupations have all experienced an increase in employees from 2005. Caring personal service occupations has seen the largest growth between 2005 and 2008, however skilled construction and building trades have had the largest decrease in employment over the 4 years.

3. Demographics

3.1 Population Change & Density

According to the 2008 mid-year population estimate there were 212,100 people resident in Gt. Yarmouth & Waveney area. This represents an increase of 4.28% in 7 years, which is below both the county and regional population growth. The population estimate for Gt. Yarmouth & Waveney has increased by 800 since 2007.

In 2001 the population stood at 154,684 in Gt. Yarmouth and Lowestoft, unfortunately due to data availability I am unable to obtain any more recent population information at this level.

There were just over 3000 more working age males than females in Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft according to the 2001 Census. This is similarly the case within Gt. Yarmouth & Waveney.

The total working age population of Great Yarmouth & Waveney in 2008 was 120,500.

Over the last 8 years the working age population of Gt. Yarmouth & Waveney has increased by 3,400 just over 5.64%%.

Due to the female working age population decreasing from 2007 to 2008 most districts and areas experienced an overall loss in their population. The only districts which experienced a rise in working age population were Forest Heath (1.49%), Ipswich (0.39%) and Norwich (2.77%). Great Yarmouth & Waveney experienced a decrease in their working age population of 1.15%.

The majority of the population of Gt.Yarmouth & Lowestoft has the ethnicity of White- British (97%), followed by White- Other with 1545 residents falling into that ethnicity. 3.5 Social Profile

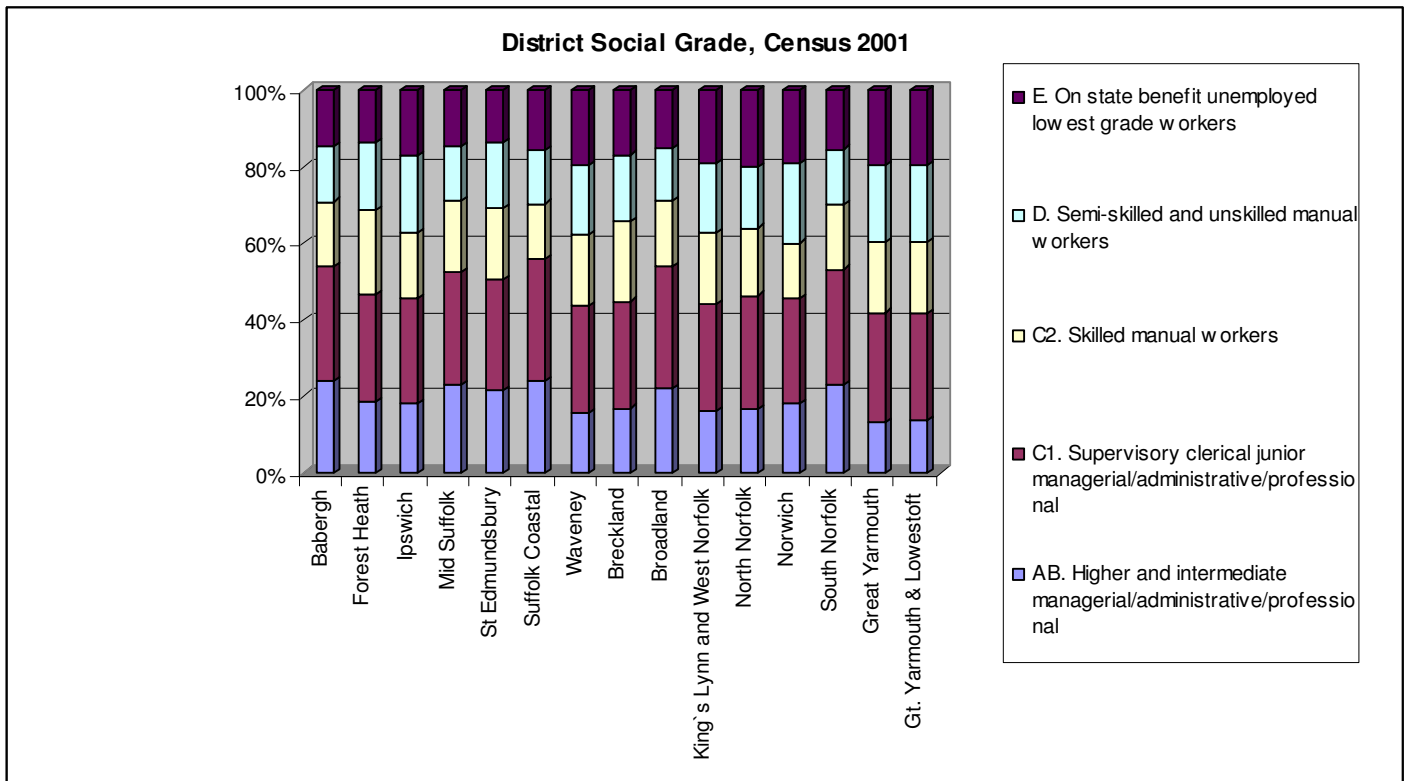

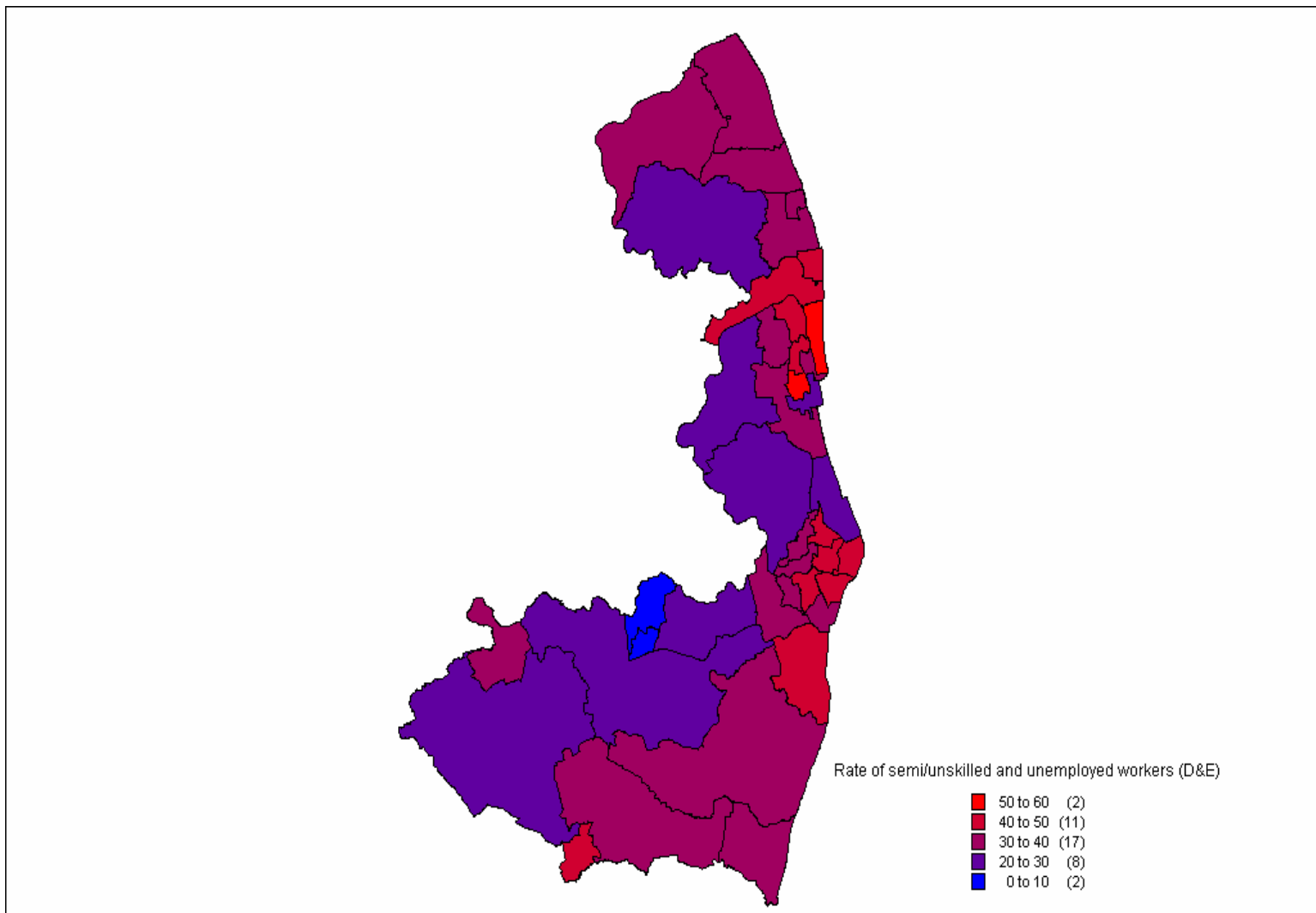

Majority of Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft's population fall into the C1 class (Supervisory clerical junior managerial/administrative/professional), which follows the same pattern of the district, counties, region and national figures.

As you can see from the graph below Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft have less of their population in the AB class than the other districts throughout Norfolk and Suffolk other than Gt. 3.5.2 Female Social Profile

The female social profile is worked out as with the overall social profile. Here we can see again that majority of people are based in the C1 class across the districts, county, region and nation. 4. Educational Attainment

4.1 Primary School Attainment

Table 8 (below) shows the percentage of year 6 pupils achieving level 4 or higher in the Key Stage 2 tests, which were sat by all primary school pupils in 2008. The Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft figures represent an average for all primary schools within the district of Gt. Yarmouth & the town of Lowestoft. Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft performs worse than the county, regional and national attainment overall. Only the district of Norwich and Waveney had lower 'all subject' attainment rates. This also follows through each of the separate subjects with Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft always having one of the lowest attainment rates.

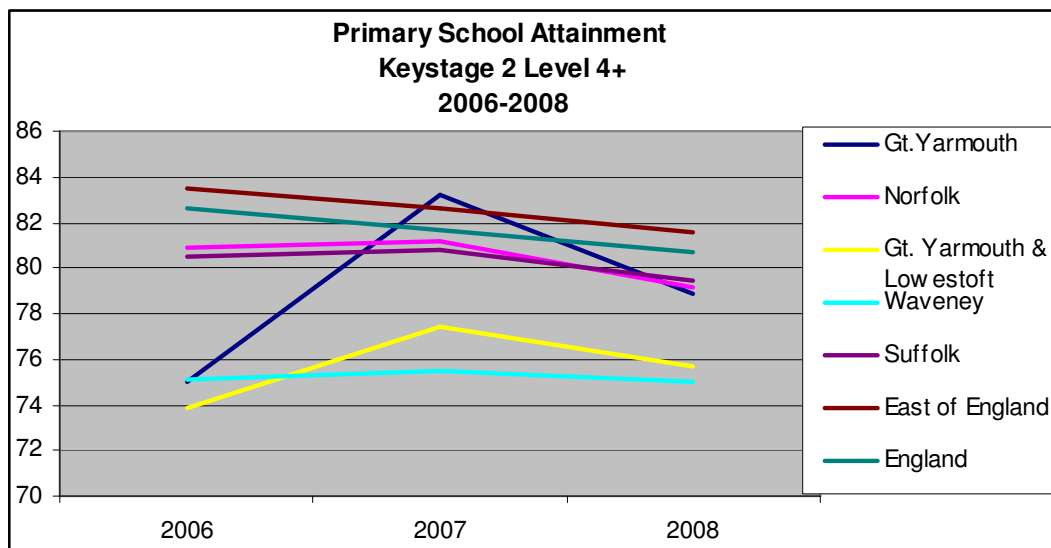

The school within the Gt. 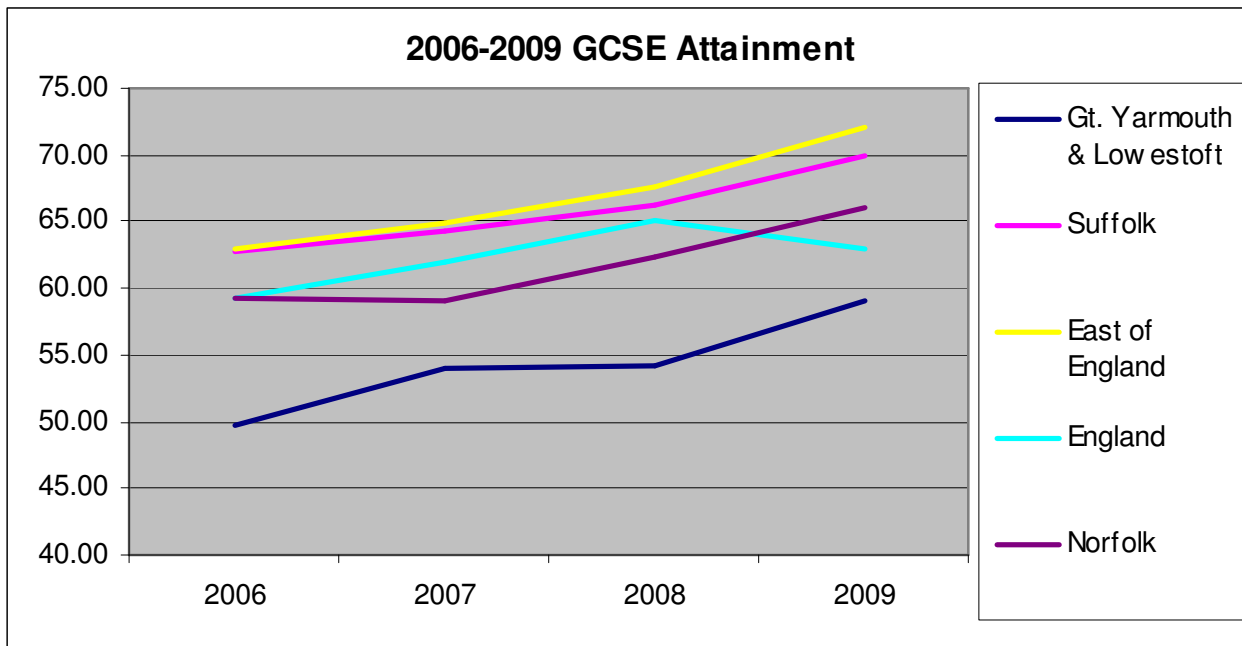

The school within the Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft area that has achieved the best performance, based on GCSE Attainment is Lynn Grove VA High School in Great Yarmouth. This achieved a pass rate of 5 or more GCSE's grades a-c of 80%. The highest achieving secondary school in Lowestoft is Benjamin Britten High School with an attainment rate of 76%.

The chart (below) shows that secondary school attainment rates in the Gt.Yarmouth & Lowestoft area have consistently been lower than the county, district and national achievement rates.

Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft performs poorly compared to the other district and the counties achieving the 5th lowest average points per student (706) with only Waveney (662), Breckland (641), Kings Lynn & West Norfolk (625) and Norwich (661) achieving a lower average.

The school within the Gt. Yarmouth & Lowestoft area that has achieved the best performance, based on A-Level average point score attainment is East Norfolk Sixth Form College in Great Yarmouth. This achieved an average point score per pupil of 858.1. Both secondary schools/colleges in Gt. Yarmouth achieved better than those in Lowestoft with the highest achievement in Lowestoft being 621 average points per pupil at Kirkley Community High School.

4.3 School Leaver Destinations

The table below shows the school leaver destinations of year 11 pupils in Great Yarmouth compared to the Norfolk average and Waveney compared to the Suffolk average. Unfortunately I am unable to do a direct comparison as the way data is collected in Norfolk and Suffolk differs meaning the headings that they fall into are not the same and therefore not comparable. However, as you can see from the table below Great Yarmouth had very few year 11 students continue to study in a Norfolk school with the majority (82%) choosing to continue their studies at a Further Educational College. This is fairly unusual when comparing to the other districts in Norfolk as most of the other districts had a fairly equal split. 73 students from Great Yarmouth went into employment (6.6%) in 2008 whilst 2.7% of the students became unemployed.

Differently to Great Yarmouth, the majority of Waveney's students opted to go to sixth form within a school (48.9%) than continue onto further education in a college (34.4%). Waveney had a higher percentage of students becoming NEET (4.8%) than Great Yarmouth (2.7%) but this may not be directly comparable as Waveney's figure includes all those not in education, employment or training whilst Great Yarmouth's is just those that became unemployed.

Great Yarmouth & Waveney area has the lowest percentage of working age population with an NVQ level 4+ (13.7%) other than Great Yarmouth as a district on it's own (11.6%). Great Yarmouth & Waveney area has below average achievement for all NVQs compared to the East of England and United Kingdom. Although, it does have a higher percentage of working age population achieving other work based qualifications than in the East of England and United Kingdom; As well as a higher percentage with no qualifications.

As with all the districts and counties the majority of the working age population has achieved an NVQ level 1.

5. Deprivation

5.1 Indices of Deprivation 2007

The Indices of Deprivation 2007 was published in April 2007 by the Office for the Deputy Prime Minister (ODPM).

Table 11 (below) provides a district summary of the overall indices of deprivation. The table shows that within the National context, the district of Gt. Yarmouth offers the highest level of deprivation across both Suffolk and Norfolk and is the 58th most deprived district in England. Waveney also offers a high level of deprivation being the 4th most deprived district across the two counties and the 114th most deprived district in England.

The Rank of Income scale shows where the district sits nationally based on income deprivation. Great Yarmouth is 119th out of 354 whilst Waveney is 120th. Out of all the Suffolk and Norfolk district this means Great Yarmouth and Waveney are 4th and 5th most deprived in the income scale.

The Rank of Employment Scale shows how deprived the districts are based on employment. Waveney is the 3rd most deprived within Suffolk and Norfolk and ranks 121 nationally. Great Yarmouth is slightly more deprived having the 2nd highest deprivation within Suffolk and Norfolk and ranking 116 nationally.

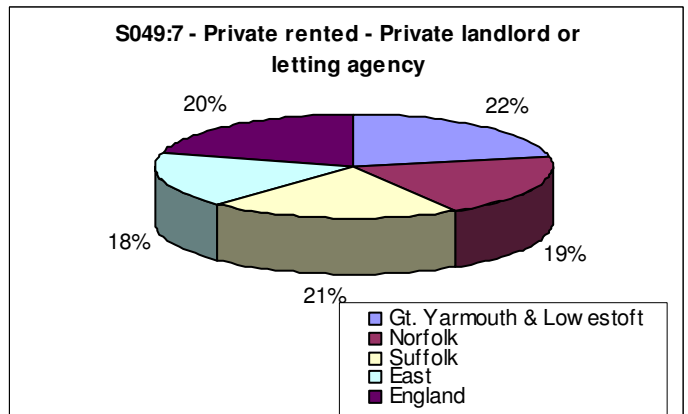
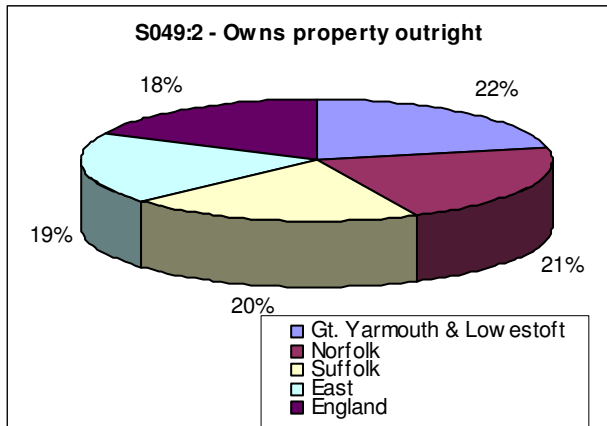
5.2 Housing Tenure

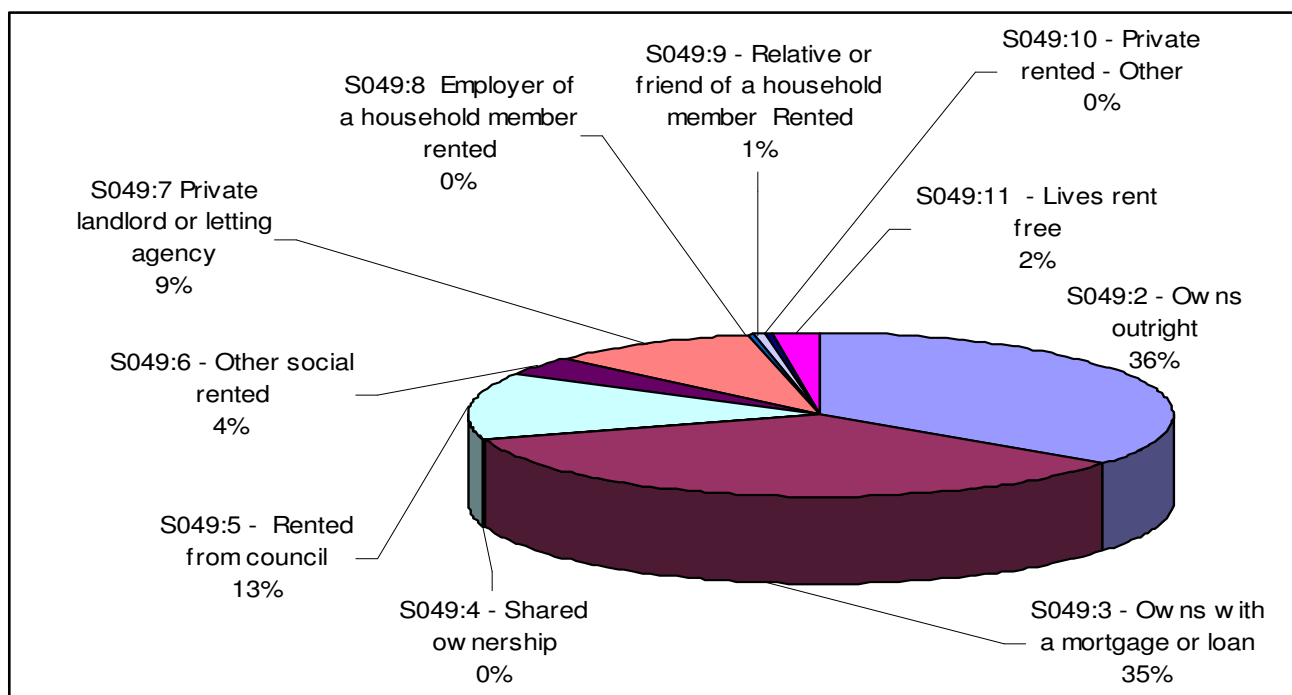

Great Yarmouth & Lowestoft area has a higher percentage of it's working age population owning their house outright (35.29%) and people renting privately through a private landlord (9.43%) than either Norfolk Suffolk East of England or England. Please see charts below:



Great Yarmouth & Lowestoft area also had a higher percentage of people living in rented accommodation with family or friends being the landlord than the other areas.

Within the area of Great Yarmouth & Lowestoft the highest percentage of its working age population owned their own house outright at 35.29%, followed by people owing their own houses but with a mortgage attached (34.71%). The area had the fewest people in rented accommodation by other means (not by letting agency, private landlord, employer or family or friend.) at 0.14% followed by rented accommodation from an employer of someone in the household (0.19%). 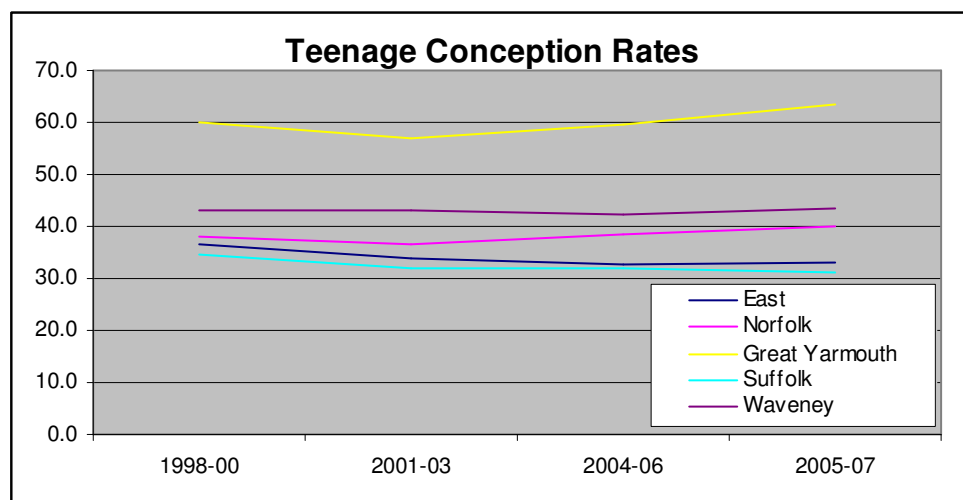
Great Yarmouth and Waveney have a fairly high percentage of people claiming Incapacity Benefit at 2.1%, which other than Great Yarmouth as a district on its own, is the highest percentage of people claiming this benefit alongside Kings Lynn & West Norfolk and North Norfolk which also had 2.1%

Waveney and Great Yarmouth have both had an increase in teenage conception rates since 1998 (1.4% & 5.7%) alongside Breckland (18.7%), Broadland (16.9%), North Norfolk (2.9%), Norwich (11.8%) and Mid Suffolk (4.2%). All but 2 of Norfolk's districts showed a rise in teenage conceptions which resulted in Norfolk displaying a rise in teenage conceptions also. Only 1 out of the 7 districts in Suffolk showed a rise in teenage conceptions, therefore meaning Suffolk showed a reduction of teenage pregnancies over the same period of time.

Great Yarmouth shows a high level of teenage pregnancies (63.5%) in 2005-2007 and is the second highest district out of all the districts of Suffolk and Norfolk. It is also higher than the county and regional rate (31.3% 39.9% & 33%) which is clearly demonstrated on the graph above. Waveney also had a rate of teenage pregnancies (43.6%) higher than the county and regional rate, although still significantly lower than Great Yarmouth.

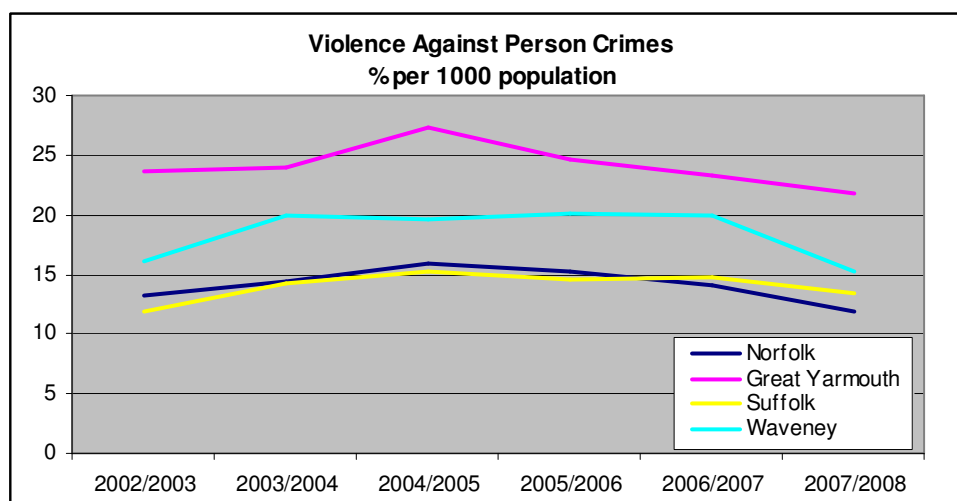

7.1 Violence against Person Crimes

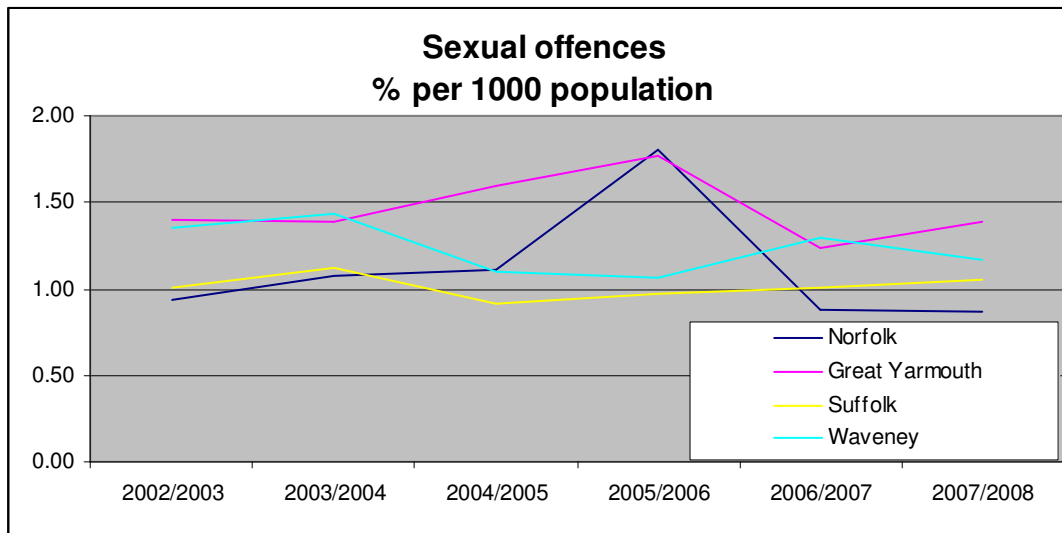

Violence against person crimes have decreased in Norfolk, Great Yarmouth and Waveney over the last 6 years. Suffolk's rate has decreased since 2003/2004 but not as much as the other districts/counties causing it to still have a higher rate of crimes than in

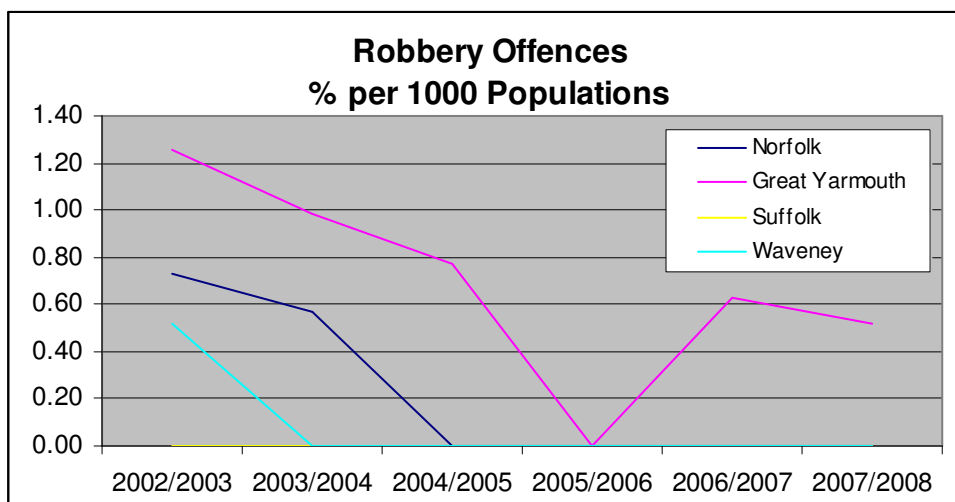

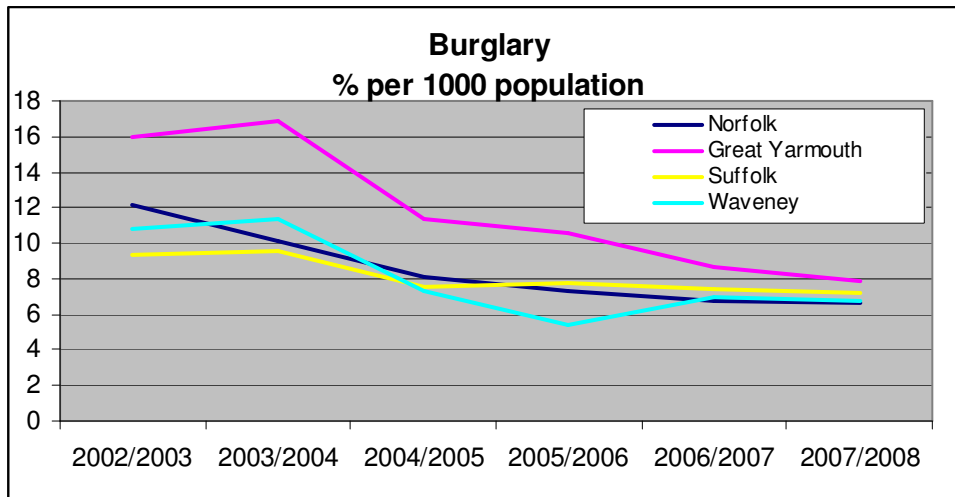

we do not even get a percentage of our population figure. Obviously there are these types of crimes within our areas but there are so few I can not really analyse this area fully.

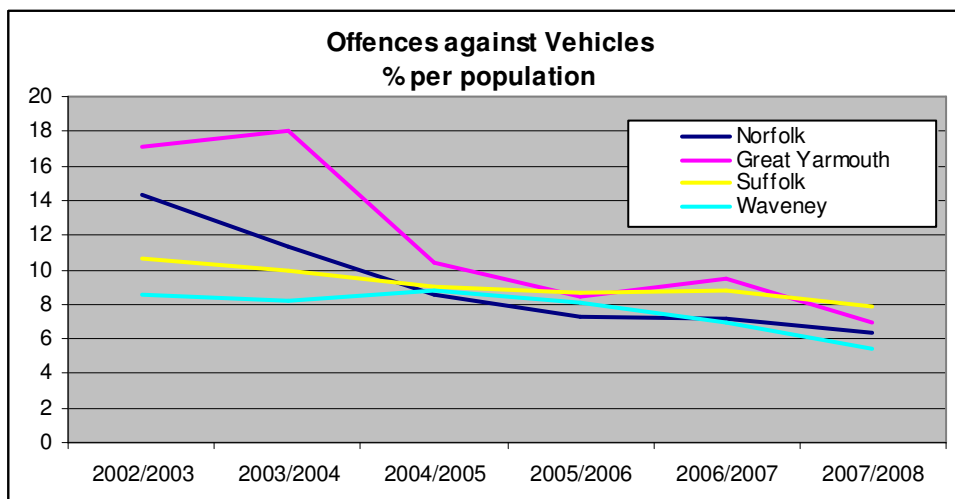
